### General MA Risk Score v. Combined SNP Risk Score<sup>2</sup>

General MA (Non-SNP)	Special Needs Plans (I-, C-, and D-SNPs)
1.03	1.9
*Combined (non-weighted) average risk score of all SNP types is 84% higher than General MA	

### General MA Risk Score v. SNP-Type Risk Score<sup>3</sup>

General MA	I-SNP	C-SNP	D-SNP
1.03	2.47 (+140%)	1.68 (+63%)	1.57 (+52%)

### Limitations in ADLs: Dual Eligibles v. Non-Dual Eligibles<sup>4</sup>

Limitations in ADLs	Non-Dual Eligibles	Dual Eligibles
No limitations in ADLs	74%	47%
Limitations in 1-2 ADLs	17%	25%
Limitations in 3-6 ADLs	8%	29%

Drug, Alcohol Dependence	4%	14%	11%	8%
